The deck lay-out makes her exceptionally easy to handle: the headsail and spinnaker halyards have been led aft to winches operated from the front of the cockpit, so that these sails can be hoisted and lowered from there, thus minimising the need to move forward. Through mast reefing makes it easy to furl the mainsail and also to reef down to any level very quickly.


These features not only save time when racing but permit a thirty-two foot boat to be handled easily and efficiently by a husband and wife.



The reasonable price of the Contessa 32 is for the complete boat. Many other boatbuilders in contrast will expect you to purchase extra fittings






and expert choice. On the Contessa 32 you will find fitted, as standard, features of the highest quality and reliability.

The inventory includes a diesel engine, 3 headsails, a mainsail and seven Lewmar winches, and also an anchor, fenders and warps.



Naturally there may be alterations for which you will be asked to pay extra—the standard interior is mahogany, but you may well prefer teak or sycamore.
